This special issue of the *Nordic Journal of Business* (*NJB*) focuses on Nordic corporate governance. The special issue consists of four articles presented at the 7th Annual Workshop of the Nordic Corporate Governance Network which was organized at Copenhagen Business School in June 2015.

The first article by Steen Thomsen (Copenhagen Business School) serves as an introduction to the special issue by reviewing the key elements of the Nordic corporate governance model. In the second article, Karin Jonnergård (Lund University and Linnaeus University) and Ulf Larsson-Olaison (Linnaeus University) analyze the persistence of the Swedish corporate governance model under international governance reforms. The third ar-
